

Daily Lesson & Activity Schedule

Jr. Pre-Kindergarten Program

6:00 am - Welcome! Learning Center Activities and Breakfast

The Jr. Pre-Kindergarten's morning includes 20 minute rotations through different "hands-on" learning centers, outside play time and a morning snack. Specific morning learning center activities include:

- **Fine Motor Activity:** Writing Practice, Lacing, etc.
- **Language Arts:** Sign Language, Spanish, Letter of the Week,
- **Active Group Play:** Blocks and Legos, Floor Puzzles
- **Dramatic Play:** Dress-up, Role Playing, Pretend
- **Math and Science:** Numbers, Math and Science Games/Activities

10:00 am - Circle Time Morning Meeting

The children and teachers sit together to discuss the day of the week, the weather, the month, the curriculum theme, the number, letter, sign language, Spanish, color and shape focus for the day. A curriculum review completes this very important daily meeting!

- **Fine Motor Activity** - Table-Top Manipulatives, Writing, Coloring

11:30 am - Lunch Time and Rest Period

2:00 pm - Learning Centers and Small Group Differentiated Instruction

- **Math and Science:** Colors, Numbers, Math and Science Games
- **Art Activity:** Painting, Pasting, Cutting, Tearing, Coloring
- **Phonics Activity:** Letter sounds, Environmental Text
- **Technology:** Educational Games

4:30 pm - Circle Time Afternoon - Daily Review

The children and teachers sit together to review the activities of the day and review the concepts taught.

5:00 pm - Learning Center Activities

The Jr. Pre-Kindergarten's day concludes with 20 minute rotations through different "hands-on" learning centers, including:

- **Music and Movement** - Singing, Dancing, Instruments
- **Fine Motor Activity** - Writing practice, Coloring; Puzzles, etc.
- **Language Arts:** Story Time and Library
- **Educational Video Presentation**
